How It Works

Audit Scheduling

Contact employers to schedule payroll audits, including if necessary, assistance from Union Business Representatives or Fund Attorneys.

Review Audit Details

Compare and review payroll records to confirm employer compliance with the respective Collective Bargaining Agreements

(1) Preliminary Results

Work with the employer to determine audit outcomes, including employee identification, preliminary results and invoices.

Billing and Collection

Prepare and issue invoices to employers and monitor payment status, including past due statements and demand letters.

Finalize Audits

Coordination thru Fund Professionals, Union Business Representatives, and Attorneys to resolve employer disputes and collections.
